Mine Action Teams composition

1. Introduction:

Current situations, circumstances of the war in Sudan expand the land that contaminated by ERW, to confront these challenges, need huge numbers of teams to intervenes in all the areas same time, and there is a shortage of EOD level 3 capacity to lead, managing and control the teams Thus NMAC provides alternative, specifications, requirements and guidance for mine action teams composition and responsibilities to ensuring that national conditions enable the effective management of mine action program and projects, and maintaining national regulations and procedures for the management of demining operations.

2. Purpose:

The purpose of mine action team's composition is to effectively utilize from available resources and improve the demining teams and teams' members and ensure effective management of mine action projects outputs.

3. Requirement:

The organizations shall add annex to their SOPs to reflect the modification of the mine action teams composition as following and sent to NMAC for approve

The teams are modified as following:

- One technical supervisor holding the third level of blasting.
- Two team leaders (so that the team can split into two groups managed by the team leaders, and the overall supervision by the team supervisor).
- Eight deminers
- One paramedic
- Two community outreach officers (CLO) to carry out the coordination, information gathering, and provide explosive Ordinance Risk Education EORE.
