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1. Over the course of December 2022, in the field of training and capacity development in mine action three training workshops were accomplished. A workshop in the Quality Management System (QMS) was convened at the National Mine Action Centre (NMAC) for the offices' staffs of the national mine action organizations. Two others training workshops in Non-Technical Survey (NTS) and Explosive Ordnance Risk Education (EORE) were respectively organized in South Kordofan state by the Danish Refugee Council (DRC) and Global Aid Hand (GAH). It is worth to mention that the information management department of NMAC has actively contributed to these latter two workshops.
2. Manual Multi-Tasks Teams (MTTs) operating in Ulu, Malkan, Al Keili, Dindero and Bullang were checked off as well as the areas they have cleared were received. Given the increasing influx of returnees to their homes of origin, the teams have been directed to prioritize areas identified for voluntary return to deliver mine action services. Two meetings were held with the purpose to coordinate for the provision of support and facilities to the teams operate in the SPLM areas with of Malkan and Ulu Headquarters. To find out about the progress of the victims' assistance project in Damazin, the victims' assistance team was also looked into.
3. At the time when seven of JASMAR MTTs in Blue Nile region, Baw locality (Ulu and Malkan) have exhausted their contract terms, three of them have their contract been extended until the end of March 2023.
4. On the other hand, the field activities of mines and explosive remnant of war clearance are progressing very well in Blue Nile region and South Kordofan State, during the month of December 2022 the following have been achieved:
  - a. **During this month 14 Hazards were registered and 17 were cleared. (See table 1-1).**
  - b. **Total of (142,219) sqm were cleared during this month (see table 2-1).**
  - c. **total of 6 (APM), 255 (SAA), and 172 (172) were destroyed during this month (See table 3-1).**
  - d. **This month, an accident was reported in South Kordofan, which involved two victims. (See table 4.1).**
  - e. **43,709 beneficiaries of EORE activity this month (see table 5.1).**
5. Since 2002 Sudan Mine Action Programme has had registered 5,049 hazard areas, where 4,651 have been cleared. In 2022 total of 255 hazardous area have been registered while 208 hazard areas have been cleared, total of 398 hazard areas remained within area of 33,841,317 sqm (see table 1-1).
6. Since the beginning of the programme the total of 137,763,559 sqm cleared and handed over to the local communities. While In 2022 a total of 1,033,631 sqm cleared from Mines/ ERW (see table 2-1).
7. Since 2002 total of 10,398 Anti-Personnel Mines (APM), 3,349 Anti-Tank Mines (ATM), 173,988 Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) and 5,811,330 Small Arms Ammunition (SAA) have been destroyed. While in 2022 a total of 32 Anti-Personnel Mines (APM), 14 Anti-Tank Mines (ATM), 2,347 UXOs and 24,976 Small Arms Ammunition (SAA) destroyed (see table 1-3).
8. Since 2002 till December 2022(2,580) victims were reported, from the mentioned total (1,941) injured and (639) killed. In 2022(25) victims were reported (4) Killed and (21) Injured. (See table 4-1).
9. To mitigate the risk of Mines/ ERW accidents, the National Mine Action Center (NMAC) in collaboration with the National and International NGOs (FPDO, JSMAR, AAR and NADA Alazhar) Mine/ ERW risk education activities have been conducted to 5,027,702 persons from the beginning of the programme and 256,834 persons during this year . (See table 5-1).
10. Since the beginning of the programme and till today a total of 38,529 km roads have been opened and cleared (see table 6-1).

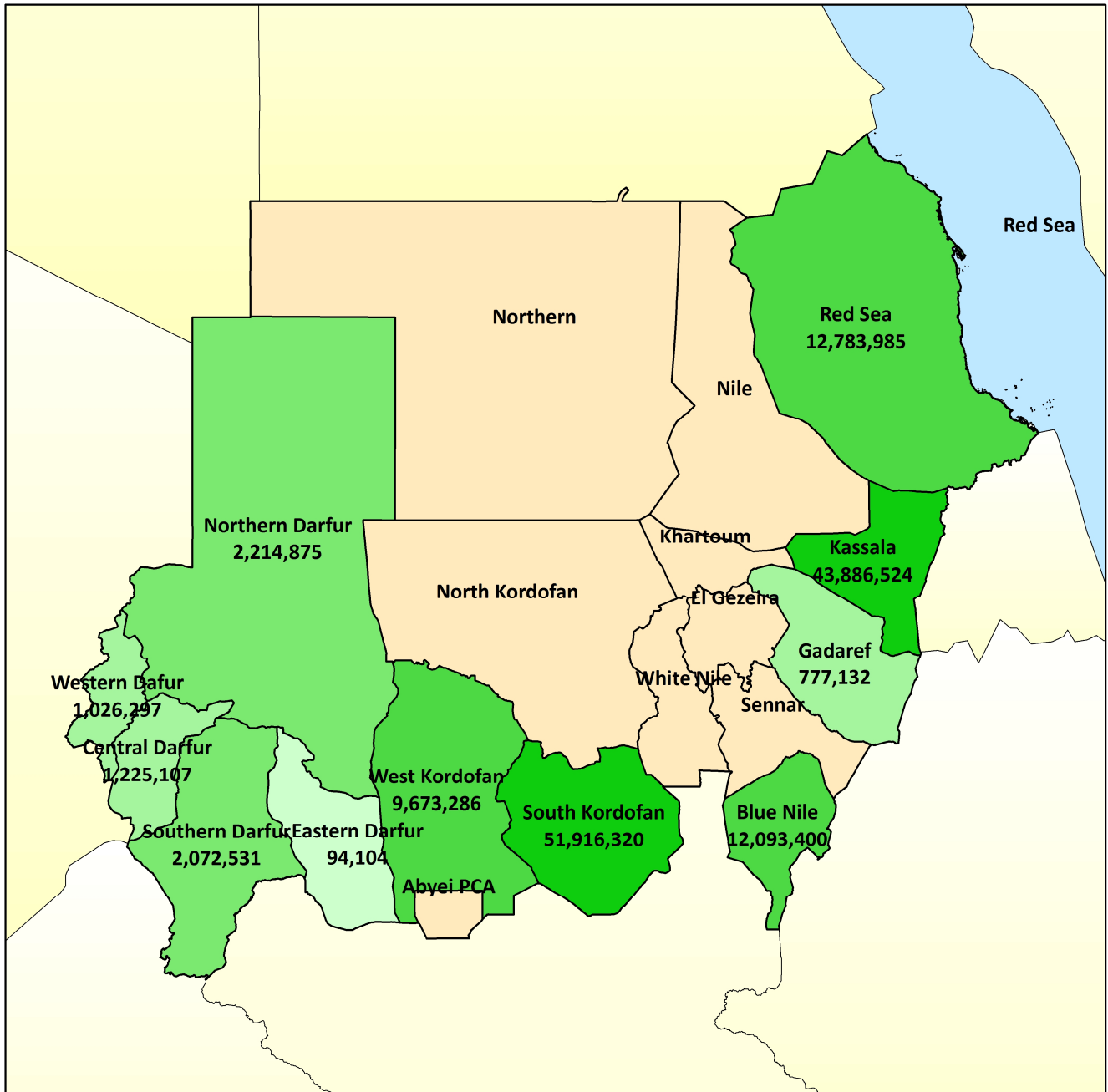

## Area Released By State



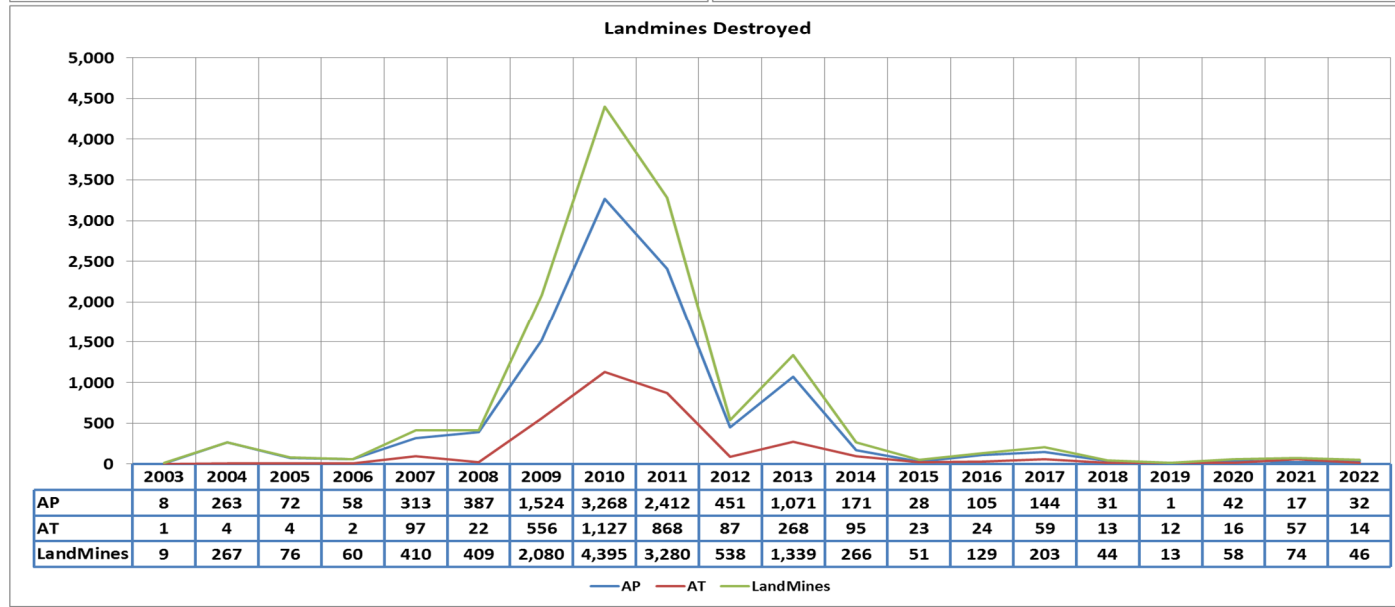
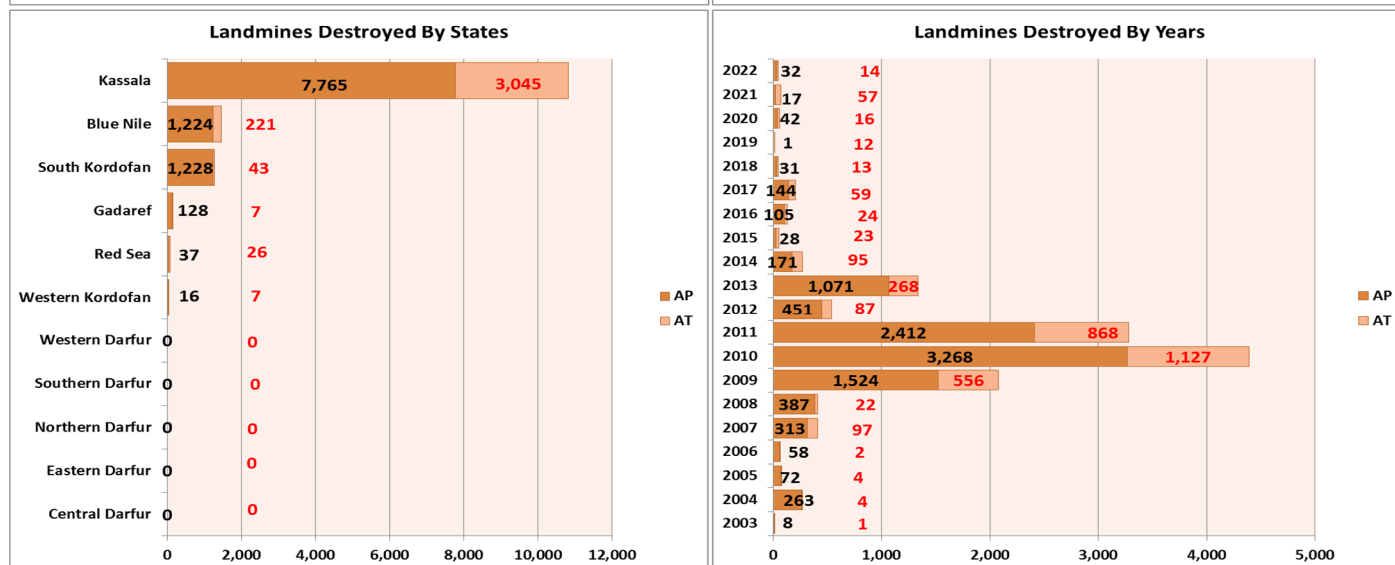
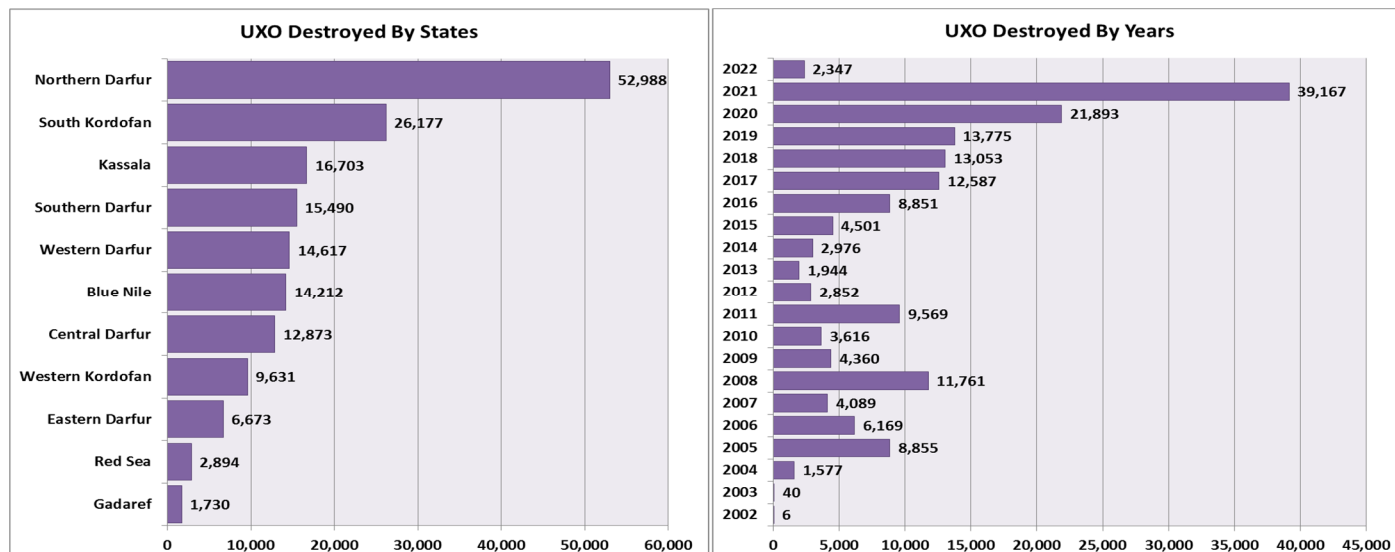

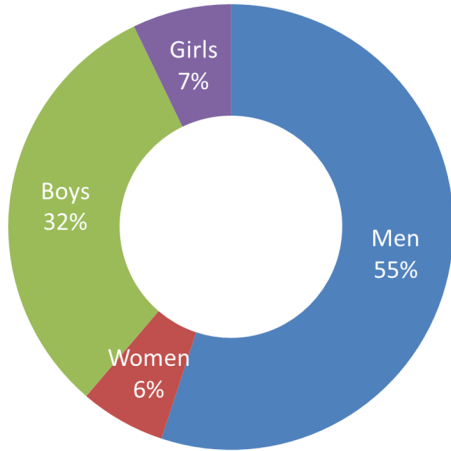

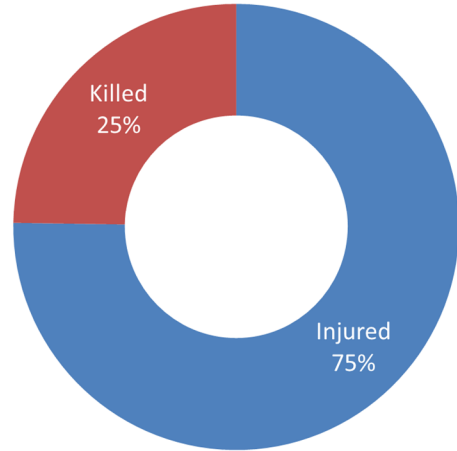


**Chart 4.4: Casualties:**

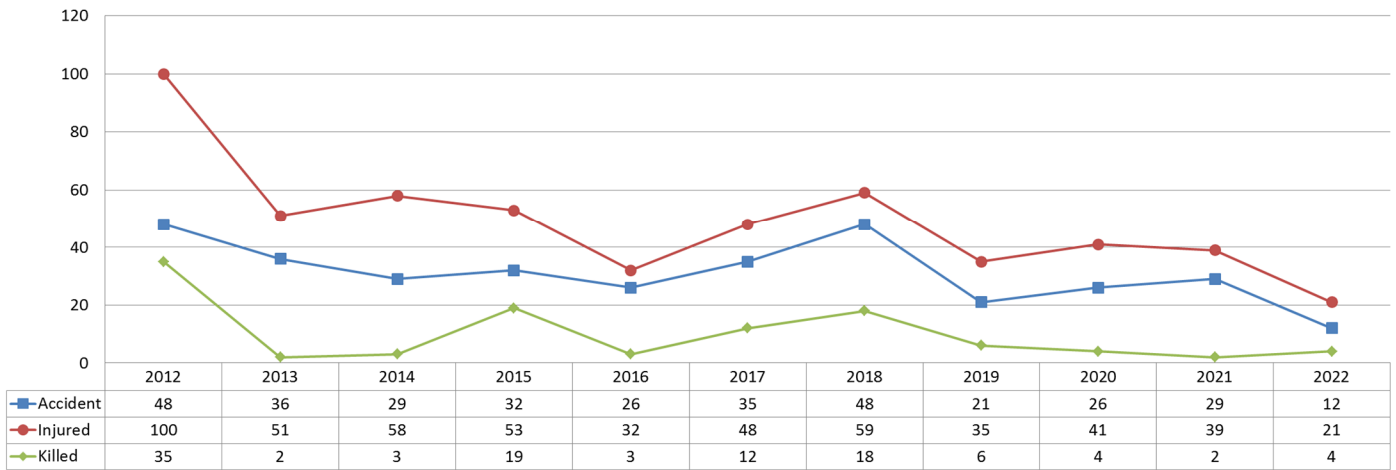
**Victims Disaggregation Boys, Girls, Men and Women**



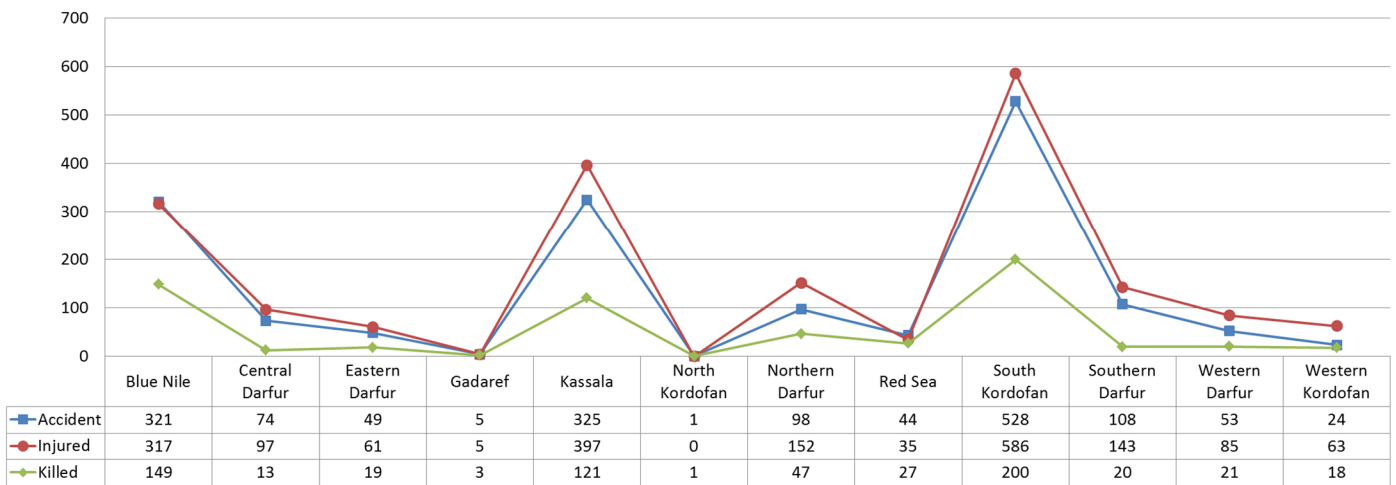
**Victims Disaggregation Killed and Injured**



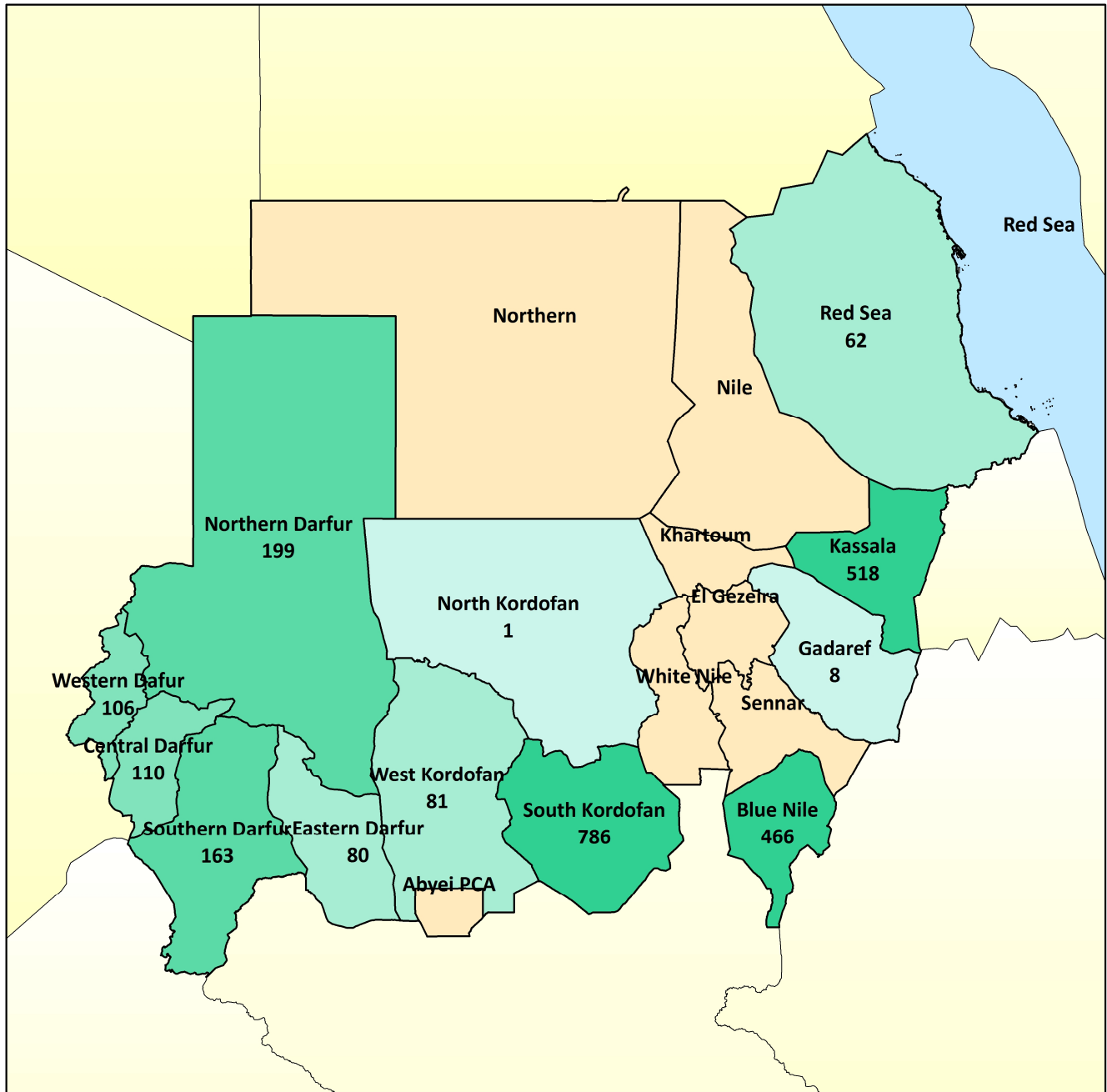
**Landmine / ERW Accidents by Years**

### Casualties Distributed By State



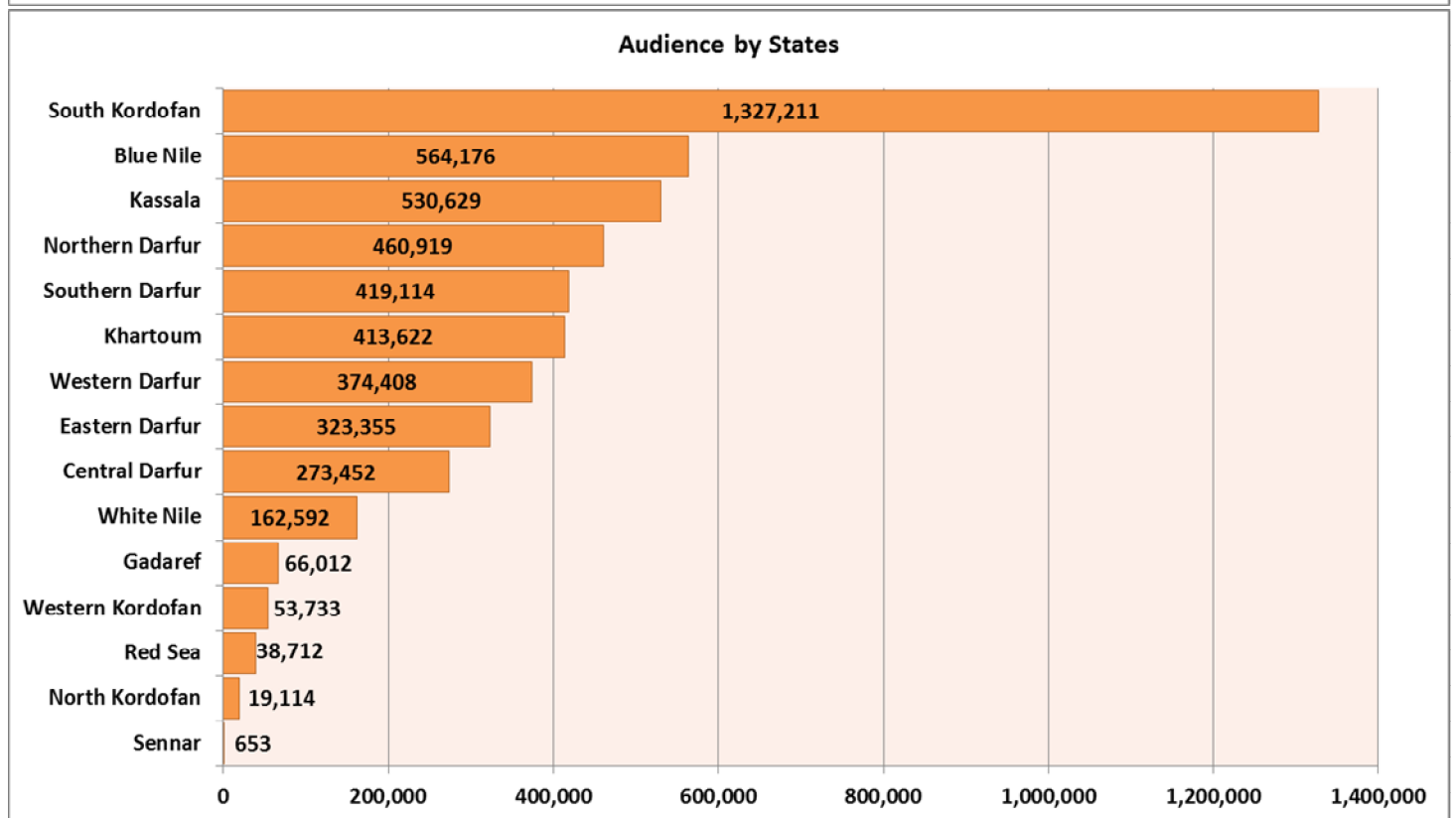
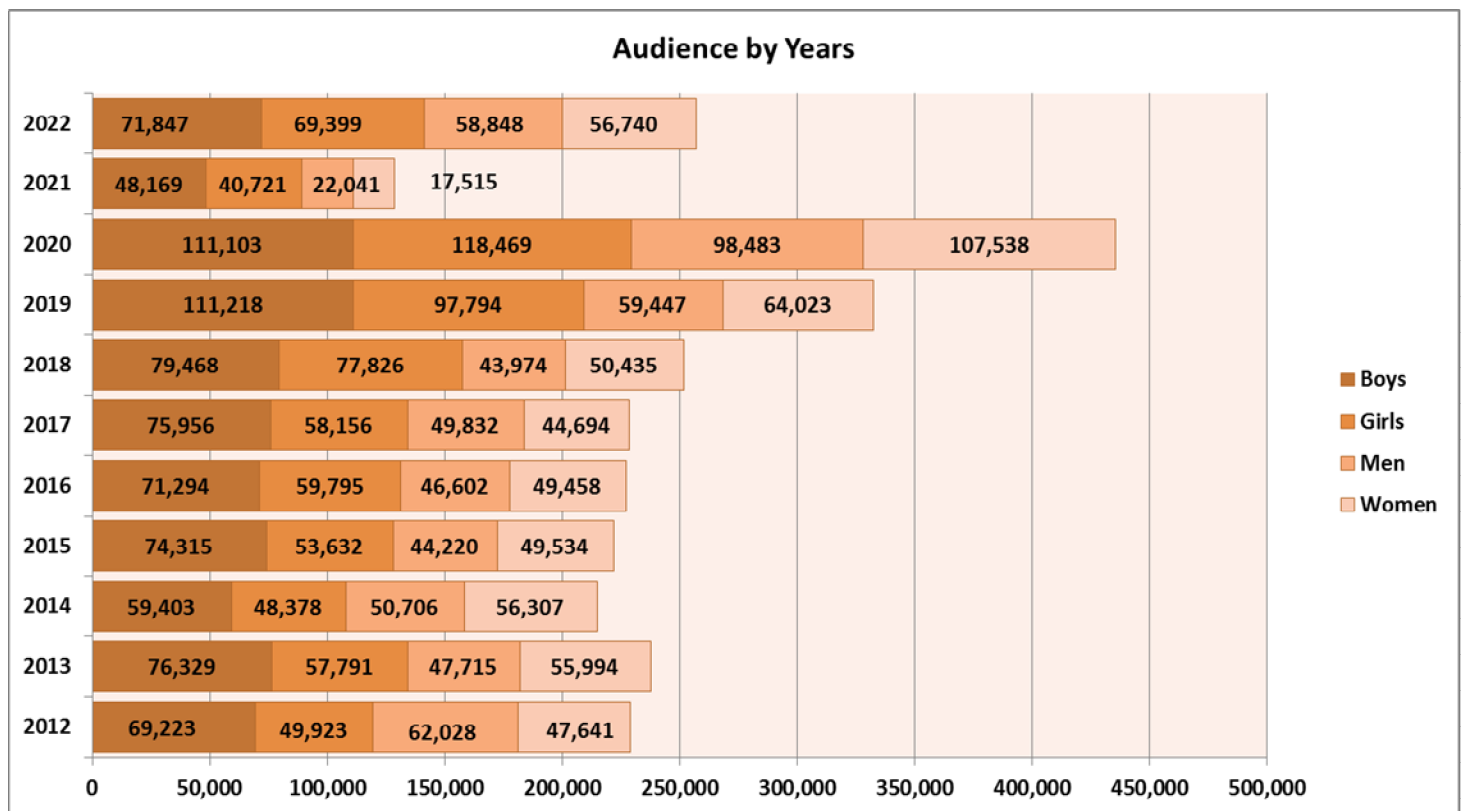

# EORE Distributed By State



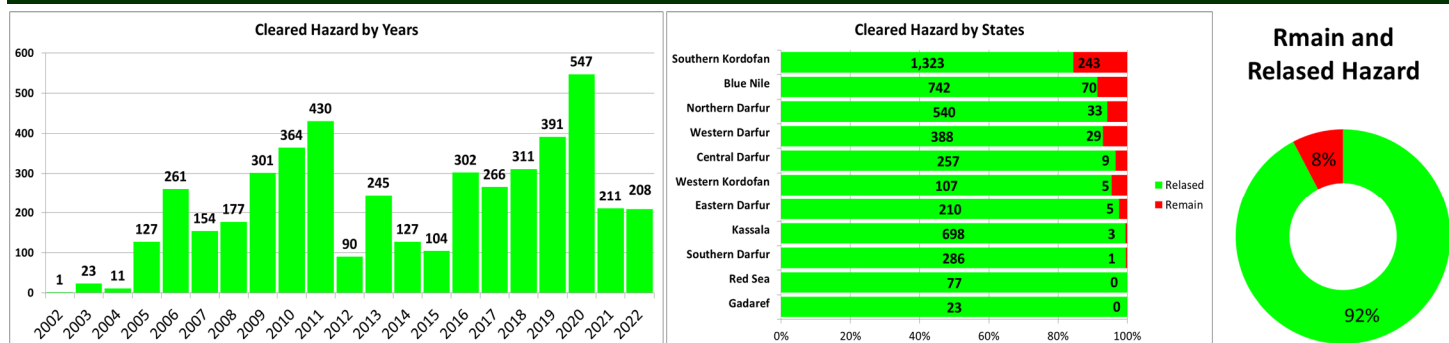

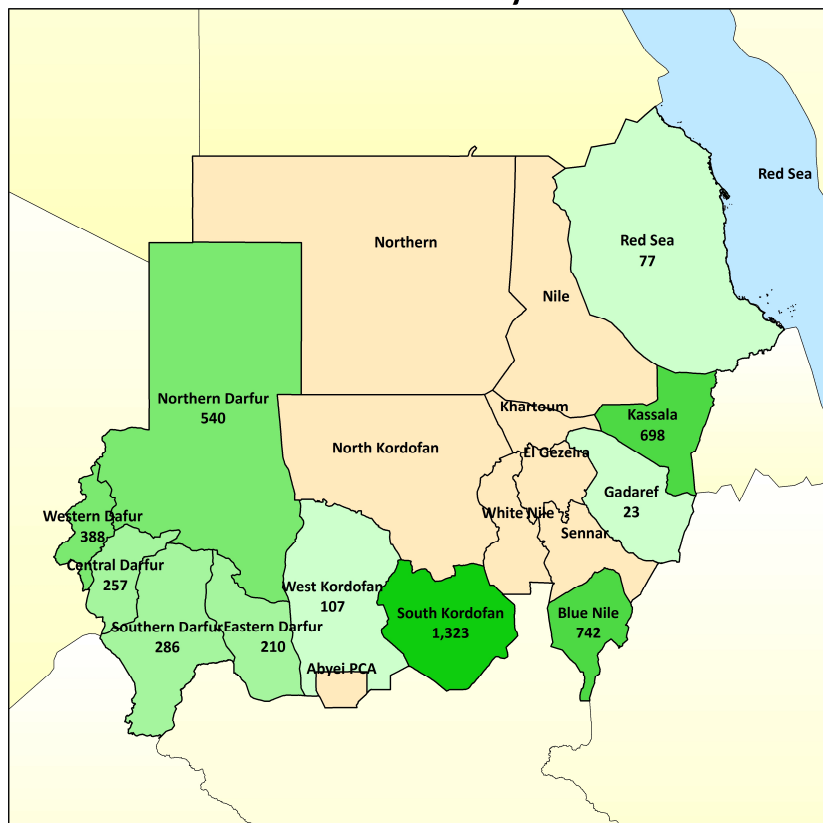

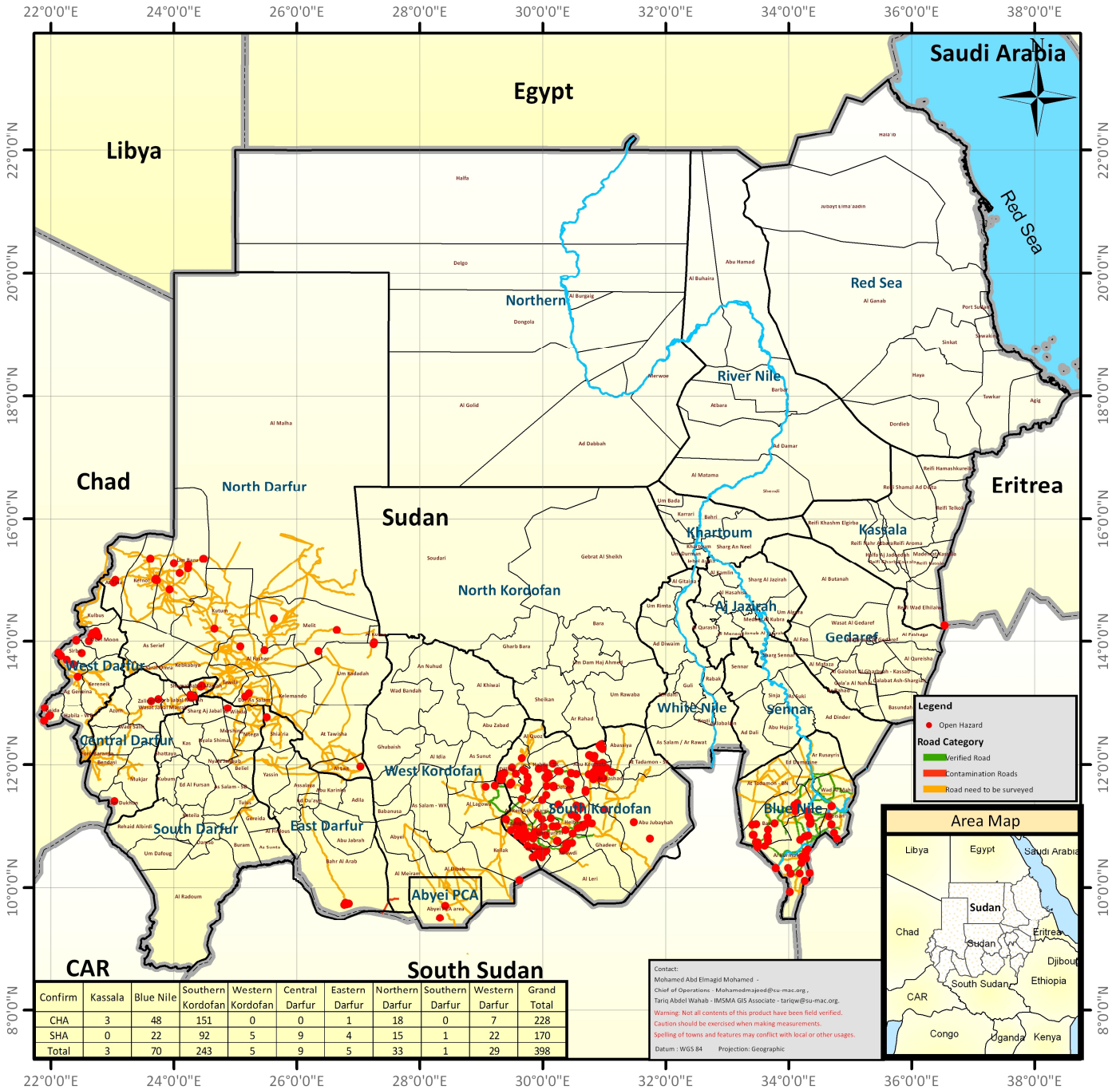
