#### <u>Ministry of Defence</u> <u>Sudan Mine Action Programme</u> <u>IMSMA Monthly Report March 2023</u>



- 1. In Marrawi conference hall, in United Nations Development Programme, the meeting of Sudan's Mine Action Support Group (MASG) was held with wide participation honored by the Secretary-General of the Ministry of Defense, the Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Sudan and Head of the United Nations Integrated Transition Assistance Mission in Sudan Mr. Volker Perthes and a large number of ambassadors and representatives of diplomatic missions and United Nations organizations in Sudan.
- 2. The workshop on Victims Assistance Strategic Framework was held on 15-16 March 2023 in Coral Hotel with wide participation from the relative ministries, national and international organizations and Unions of persons with disabilities.
- 3. The month witnessed the graduation of thirteen trainees from the National Mine Action Center (NMAC) on basic humanitarian demining and explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) level-2, dignified by a number of military attaches to Sudan.
- 4. Preparations to celebrate the International Mine Action Awareness and Assistance Day were continuing as the final perception of the day which will be held at the Friendship Hotel in Khartoum has been endorsed.
- 5. On the other hand, the field activities of mines and explosive remnant of war clearance are progressing very well in Blue Nile region and South Kordofan State, during the month of March 2023 the following have been achieved:
  - a. During this month (8) Hazards were registered and (21) hazards were cleared. (See table 1-1).
  - b. Total of (161,521) sqm were cleared during this month (see table 2-1).
  - c. total of 3 (APM), 41 (ATM), 268 (UXO) and 2,186 (SAA) were destroyed during this month (See table 3-1).
  - d. This month, no any an accident was reported. (See table 4.1).
  - e. 6,205 beneficiaries of EORE activity this month (see table 5.1).
- 6. Since 2002 Sudan Mine Action Programme has had registered 5,071 hazard areas, where 4,676 have been cleared. In 2023 total of 21 hazardous area have been registered and 25 hazard areas have been cleared, total of 395 hazard areas remained within area of 33,916,872 sqm (see table 1-1).
- 7. Since the beginning of the programme the total of 138,090,359 sqm cleared and handed over to the local communities. While In 2023 a total of 326,800 sqm cleared from Mines/ ERW (see table 2-1).
- 8. Since 2002 total of 10,403 Anti-Personnel Mines (APM), 3,417 Anti-Tank Mines (ATM), 174,613 Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) and 5,813,549 Small Arms Ammunition (SAA) have been destroyed. While in 2023 a total of 5 Anti-Personnel Mines (APM), 68 Anti-Tank Mines (ATM and 625 (UXO) and 2,219 Small Arms Ammunition (SAA) destroyed (see table 1-3).
- 9. Since 2002 till March 2023(2,612) victims were reported, from the mentioned total (1,973) injured and (639) killed. In 2023 (1) victim was reported (Injured). (See table 4-1).
- 10. To mitigate the risk of Mines/ ERW accidents, the National Mine Action Center (NMAC) in collaboration with the National and International NGOs (FPDO, JSMAR, AAR and NADA Alazhar) Mine/ ERW risk education activities have been conducted to 5,042,309 persons from the beginning of the programme and 14,607 persons during this year. (See table 5-1).
- 11. Since the beginning of the programme and till today a total of 38,529 km roads have been opened and cleared (see table 6-1).







# **ERW Destroyed By State**


